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ACCREDITATION VS AUTHORISATION

Accreditation

third-party attestation related to a *conformity assessment body* conveying formal demonstration of its competence to carry out specific conformity assessment tasks

Authoritative body that performs *accreditation*

Note 1 to entry: The authority of an accreditation body is generally derived from government.

Conformity assessment body

body that performs conformity assessment activities and that can be the object of *accreditation* (3.1)

Note 1 to entry: Whenever the term “conformity assessment body” is used in the text, it applies to both the applicant and accredited conformity assessment bodies, unless otherwise specified.

About ISO/IEC 17024:2012

ISO/IEC 17024:2012, Conformity assessment – General requirements for bodies operating certification of persons

The international Standard ISO/IEC 17024:2012 Conformity assessment– General requirements for bodies operating certification of persons, provides a global benchmark for quality certification. During recent years, this standard, developed by the International Organization for Standardization (ISO), which represents members from 162 countries has changed the way certifications are offered and has harmonized expectations for what constitutes quality certifications throughout the world.

This standard was developed by ISO based on the need for public protection by establishing that individuals have the required competencies to perform their job. Government agencies worldwide have recognized the standard as a critical requirement for personnel certification bodies that offer certification in many industries including diverse and critical areas related to public health, environment, and national security.

Introduction

This International Standard has been developed with the objective of achieving and promoting a globally accepted benchmark for organizations operating certification of persons. Certification for persons is one means of providing assurance that the certified person meets the requirements of the certification scheme.

The development of certification schemes for persons, in response to the ever increasing velocity of technological innovation and growing specialization of personnel, can compensate for variations in education and training and thus facilitate the global job market.

This International Standard can serve as the basis for the recognition of the certification bodies for persons and the certification schemes under which persons are certified, in order to facilitate their acceptance at the national and international levels. Only the harmonization of the system for developing and maintaining certification schemes for persons can establish the environment for mutual recognition and the global exchange of personnel

The requirements in this International Standard are considered to be general requirements for bodies providing certification of persons.

BASE OF ACCREDITATION

Accreditation is based on demonstrating compliance with specified requirements for competence, independence and impartiality.

COMPETENCE

The experience and technical skills of the staff in the accredited or applicant body are verified by qualified assessors with relevant expertise and specialised knowledge.

INDEPENDENCE

Accredited bodies that grant certification shall show independence from the organisation to which their services are provided.

IMPARTIALITY

Accredited bodies shall show absence or proper management of conflicts of interest with the client to whom they provide services.

Purpose of ISO 17024

ISO 17011:2017 specifies requirements for the competence, consistent operation and impartiality accreditation (authorisation) bodies
